

Amity, Womelsdorf mosquitoes test positive for West Nile

Mosquito samples from Amity Township and Womelsdorf have tested positive for the West Niles virus, state officials said Wednesday.

The samples were among 17 statewide that tested positive, according to the West Nile Control Program.

The Department of Environmental Protection and county officials said they are continuing to respond with surveillance and control.

Among the other counties affected, and the number of positive samples, are: Adams and Lancaster, two each; and Chester, Cumberland, Fayette, Lackawanna, Luzerne, Northampton and Philadelphia, one each.
