## Assistant fire chief's pickup, with light bar, stolen in Amity

A pickup truck belonging to Monarch Fire Company Assistant Chief Robert Kline was stolen from his Amity Township residence, police said Friday.

The truck should not be hard to spot: it's a blue, 1996 Ford F250 diesel with an extended cab, red light bar on top and a Monarch Fire Company hologram plate on the front, police said.

The thief apparently picked the lock and ignition between 9 and 10:30 p.m. Thursday while the truck was at Kline's residence in the 3000 block of Limekiln Road, police said.
