

At Amity Township meeting, Boone Area Library asks for residents to fill two board positions

AMITY TWP. - The Boone Area Library has put out a call for Amity Township residents to fill two vacant positions on the library board of trustees.

According to information from library officials at the township supervisors meeting Wednesday, trustee Susan Davis is resigning due to time constraints and another position is vacant.

The board is made up of residents of Amity and Union townships and Birdsboro.

Library officials said a meet-and-greet would be held Nov. 1 at the library to welcome Director Wayne Lahr.

In other business, the supervisors voted unanimously to:

- Approve a resolution to post hunting dates for Monocacy Hill.

- Approve a resolution to shred employee records that are more than five years old.

An executive session was held to discuss police negotiations, potential litigation and personnel. No action was taken and details were unavailable.
