

Amity supervisor arraigned on DUI charge

An Amity Township supervisor who was in a two-vehicle accident near Pottstown that injured a child was arraigned Tuesday on drunken driving and related charges.

Terry Jones, 46, of Amity was charged last week by West Pottsgrove Township police with driving under the influence, reckless endangerment of another person and careless driving.

Jones had arranged with police to turn himself in for his arraignment before District Judge Thomas A. Palladino, Pottstown. He was freed on \$30,000 bail to await further court action.

According to police:

Jones drove a sport utility vehicle into the path of a car driven by Shannon Nester, 24, Stowe, in the 1600 block of West High Street in West Pottsgrove about 7:30 p.m. on Feb. 11.

Nester and her 3-year-old daughter suffered unspecified injuries in the crash.

The girl, who was unrestrained in Nester's car, was flown by helicopter to Lehigh Valley Hospital near Allentown. Police did not release the girl's name. Information on her condition could not be obtained.

Nester, who was treated in the same hospital for unspecified injuries, was charged with recklessly endangering another person and operating a vehicle with improper restraints. She also turned herself in for arraignment before Palladino on Tuesday and remained free to await further court action.

Jones was treated for unspecified injuries in Pottstown Hospital. Information on his blood-alcohol level was unavailable.
