

Old Airport Road bridge in Amity to close for repairs

PennDOT has announced that work will begin June 14 to replace the deck and beams on the Old Airport Road Bridge over Manatawny Creek in Amity Township.

During construction, Old Airport Road will be closed and detoured between PA 662 and PA 562. The posted detour utilizes PA 662 and PA 562. Motorists are advised to allow for extra time when traveling through the area.

The project is expected to be complete in May 2012. All schedules are weather dependent.

Nyleve Bridge Corp. of Emmaus, Pa. is the general contractor on the \$1,003,403 project.

The Old Airport Road Bridge is a concrete box beam bridge originally constructed in 1962. The Bridge is 156 feet long and 33 feet wide with an average daily traffic of 1,922 vehicles.
