

## Township gains \$62,000 with insurance refund

Amity Township has been refunded more than \$62,000 from its insurance provider because of a low number of worker's compensation and liability insurance claims in 2012.

Insurance agent Richard I. Hart presented supervisors with a check during the meeting Wednesday night.

Board member Robert R. Yanos said the township's insurance claims were lower than the industry standard.

It was the sixth straight year the township received a dividend check, Hart said.

In another matter, board members agreed to allow the Daniel Boone Homestead to hook into the township sewer system.

The homestead's owner, the state Department of General Services, has determined that the historic site needs public sewer service.

Also, supervisors announced that PennDOT will close a section of Railroad Bridge Road for two years, beginning May 6 for repairs on two bridges.
