Daniel Boone student arrested at school on drug charges

State police arrested a student on drug charges Tuesday at Daniel Boone High School after a search of his home uncovered marijuana, cocaine and drug paraphernalia, officials said.

Joshua A. Faust, 18, of the 700 block of Nicholson Avenue, Douglassville, was charged with possessing and intending to deliver marijuana and possessing cocaine and drug paraphernalia.

He was awaiting arraignment late Tuesday in Reading Central Court.

Amity Township police said they executed a search warrant at Faust's home along with state troopers and an Exeter Township police drug dog.

They said they seized three bags of marijuana, a marijuana bud, two bags of cocaine, three plastic bags with cocaine residue, a digital scale and \$345.

Police said they conducted the search after receiving information about drug dealing in the neighborhood.

State police said they interviewed Faust at the high school and learned that he bought an ounce or two of marijuana and sold small amounts.

Faust was arrested and turned over to Amity police.

Troopers said the money seized in the house included recorded bills used in police-controlled drug buys at Faust's home.
