Gunman robs Amity Township pizza restaurant

A man with a gun robbed two employees of an Amity Township pizza restaurant early Sunday as they were closing for the night, police said.

No one was injured in the 1:40 a.m. holdup at Domino's Pizza, 1139 W. Benjamin Franklin Highway, township police said.

Police gave this account:

The employees, whom police did not identify, were outside locking the front door when a man approached pointing a handgun at them.

The robber ordered them back into the restaurant. At his demand, they gave him the night deposit and money from the safe.

The robber ordered the workers to walk out the back door and get into a large trash container, but it was locked.

He then told them to lie face down and ran off.

The robber was described as a thin Latino man about 5 feet 5 inches tall wearing a black hooded pull-over sweat shirt, blue jeans and a navy blue bandanna covering his face.
