Berks County detectives arrested an Amity Township man Friday, Aug. 20, on charges of planning to sell marijuana and related offenses.

According to a news release:

On May 6, an undercover detective bought a ½-pound of marijuana for \$700 from Adam Oppelt, Washington Township, on East Chestnut Street in Bechtelsville.

Investigators arrested Oppelt in Chester County on June 18.

Detectives say the arrest led them to an accomplice, Matthew Nettles, 23, Amity Township.

On July 21, they searched Nettles' home and found about ½-pound of marijuana, \$4,665, a digital scale, and two handguns.

They arrested Nettles in his home Friday, Aug. 20.
