

Lack of fees gets area notary in trouble

AMITY - A Douglassville notary is charged with failing to submit vehicle title transfer records and more than \$46,000 in fees to the state department of transportation in a timely manner, the state police at Reading released.

Marianne Wengert, 55, of 370 Old Philadelphia Pike, is charged with attempted theft or failure to make required disposition of funds received and tampering with public records. Wengert, the owner of Tri County Financial Services & Notary Services, also owns a second location in Pottstown.

State police said Wengert sent a check for more than \$53,000 in April to PennDOT. The fees were discovered as a result of an audit by PennDOT.
