

Presentations made on sewer plant work

Amity Township officials heard presentations from engineering firms looking to bid on a contract for work at the municipal sewer plant.

The presentations were given at a meeting Thursday of the board of supervisors held at the Amity plant at 120 Old Philadelphia Pike.

"Sewer treatment facilities of all ages require maintenance projects throughout their life spans," Chairman Robert Yanos said. "The facility we have in Amity has gone through several expansions and maintenance projects over the years; it's just something that has to be done."

The township will choose from among ARRO Engineering, Wyomissing; Entech Engineering, Reading; and LTL Consultants Ltd., Oley.

The township heard several options and, depending on which is chosen, anticipates spending between \$500,000 and \$2 million.
